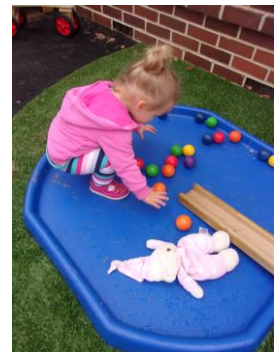
We would like to welcome Shelaney and Michelle to our growing team.

Appropriate Clothing

Due to the great British weather, we do ask all parents to provide your child with suitable clothing for the day. **Rain coats with hoods, and wellies are a must.** The children go out in all types of weather! Please provide these every day when your child comes into nursery. Please make sure all items of clothing are clearly named.



All clothes and bags need to be taken home at the end of each session, this is due to the amount of children that we have in now and the space for all of their belongings. If your child is attending the next day it will be ok to leave their items here overnight for the next day.

Policy and Procedures – What to do if your child is unwell.

If your little one has a cold, they can attend nursery if you feel that they are able to cope with a busy nursery day. We are not able to give them any medication unless a doctor prescribes it. If your child has diarrhoea or vomiting, they must be free of any symptoms for 48 hours before returning to nursery. We have more information on infections and what to do in the nursery – please ask if you would like to see it. If you know your child is not attending nursery, please could you ring and let us know.
